#### WELLS FAMILY MEET IN JOHNSON COUNTY FOR THEIR REUNION

The descendants of the Revolutionary War soldier *Richard Wells*, 1760-1838 and his wife *Susannah Hutchison Wells*, 1779-1862 celebrated with a reunion on August 31 and September 1, 2002 at the Johnson Central High School, Paintsville, Kentucky.

The reunion began on Saturday with approximately 75 members. Many in this group were descendants of Richard Wells through his son William Green Wells's line -- his daughter, Susanna Wells Clark and granddaughter, Unoka Clark Richmond and through Richard Wells daughter, Agnes Wells Auxier's line -- her daughter, Angeline Auxier Richmond and her spouse Samuel Buchanan Richmond.

Family members enjoyed a tour of their ancestor gravesites, lead by *Manford Walton*. *Afterwards*, a wonderful dinner prepared by the *Wells/Richmond* members provided time for enjoyable conversation.

John B. Wells III and the Historical Committee had a genealogical workshop. John informed the group that he and Bobby Wells participated in a DNA drawing in the spring of 2001 and the results proved:

- 1. The *Richard Wells* of the Big Sandy Valley of KY and the *Humphrey Wells*, *Jr*. family of Rutherford County, NC, are one in the same family and are very closely related. It appears that Richard Wells and Humphrey Wells, Jr. <u>were brothers</u>. The certainty of the results is 99.3%
- The Big Sandy Richard Wells family does not descend from Richard Wells, Sr. who married Nancy Brown. Direct descendants of that line were tested and their results show absolutely no relationship to our family. We differ on 21 markers! The certainty of the results is 99.3%.

3. The available results indicate that the *Richard Wells* family of the Big Sandy Valley of Kentucky descends from Zorobabel Wells and his father Richard Wells who was born 1618 in Harbury, Warwickshire, England. This is possible only if there are unbroken Wells's markers that match other descendants of English Wells's families or with the unbroken Wells's male line. These results will become more definite during Phase II testing with a larger pool of participants.




Christy Wilburn with Randy Wells, President, presenting her with the 2002 Scholarship

Dear Mary,

Enclosed is the promised picture of the gravestone I had set in Gantz Cemetery, Jefferson County, Iowa for *Alberta Wells*, infant sister of my mother.

At last the elusive son of *Andrew Wells*, *Dr. William M. Wells*, has been found. In response to my inquiry, the Mahaska County Historical Society in Oskaloosa, Iowa has notified me that he is buried in Forest Cemetery, lot 24, section 22, in Oskaloosa. His marker reads: Dr. *William M. Wells*, age 61yr, 10mo, and 0 days, died April 28, 1887. If I figure right, this makes his birth date 28 June 1826 and means he was the first-born and his brother, *Rufus Morgan* the second child. I am writing the historical

society today to see if they have any information about any descendants. Will forward any information I get. You have no idea how long I have looked for this man and, in three trips to Iowa, how many cemeteries I have walked, stone by stone. I am also going to ask for a picture of his stone, if there is one.

This is all the new Wells information I have for today.

#### RECIPES

The continuations of the recipes of the late Fanny Richmond Wells provided by a granddaughter Marlene Sturgill Jarvis.

#### FRUIT COCKTAIL CAKE

Cream ½ cup butter or margarine 1-1/2 cups granulated sugar, add - 1/4 cup brown sugar, 1/4 tsp. Salt, 2 eggs, 1 tsp. Vanilla - mix 2 cups flour sifted with 2 tsp. Soda.

Blend well, then add – 1 medium size can well drained fruit cocktail and ½ cup nuts Bake in oblong pan about 45 minutes at 350 degrees.

TOPPING - Boil 1 minute stirring constantly ½ cup

butter, ½ cup milk, ¾ cup sugar ad ½ tsp. Vanilla. Add coconut and nuts and pour over cake.

#### HAWAIIAN CROWN CAKE

3 cups sifted swans down cake flour

2 tsp. baking powder

1-1/2 tsp. salt

1-3/4 cups sugar

1 cup shortening (room temp.)

1-1/2 cups milk

3/4 tsp. almond extract

3 eggs and 1 yolk, unbeaten

(With vegetable shortening, use 34 cup milk, with butter use ½ cup milk) Measure flour, baking power, salt and sugar into sifter. Stir shortening to soften. Sift in dry ingredients, add milk and extract. Beat 2 minutes at medium speed or 300 vigorous strokes by hand. Cool in pan 15 minutes then loosen and turn right side up on rack to cool. Serve cake plain or with whipped cream topping.

#### BLACK RASPBERRY CAKE

#### Dissolve-

1 tsp. baking soda in 1 cup of buttermilk

2 cups white sugar.

1 cup butter

3 cups all purpose flour

3 eggs, (slightly beaten)

½ tsp. cloves, 1-tsp. nutmeg, allspice, cinnamon and baking powder

Add last – 1-cup black raspberries (1-can) bake one hour in 350-degree oven (use tube pan or 2 (8" pans)

FROSTING - 1 stick melted butter - add 1 cup light brown sugar and cook 2 minutes, then add 1/3 cup milk and let come to a boil then cool to lukewarm. Add 1-3/4 to 2 cups powdered sugar and beat with mixer until creamy. Add ½ cup chopped pecans. Spread over cake.

Have a letter of acceptance from the school in which you plan to enroll in the fall (This has been defined broadly to include any recognized institution such as a vocational or technical institute, junior or community college, regular four-year college, or university that grants a certificate, diploma, or degree based on a planned program of study.)
- 4. Complete the scholarship application form.
- 5. Have a minimum 2.0 ("C") GPA on a 4.00 scale. This is to be verified by the signature of a high school administrator or counselor on the application form. Submit a pedigree chart of family line, using the format provided by the historical committee.
- 6. Agree to use the scholarship money during the first academic year for which it is given or return the amount to the Wells Association Board Treasurer.
- 7. Agree to send a copy of your first year semester/quarter grades to the President of the Wells Family Association, Inc. Board.

#### APPLICATION DEADLINE

The completed scholarship application form and pedigree chart must be postmarked by July 2, 2002, *Mail to:* Dr. Randall L. Wells, 10337 Timberwood Circle, Louisville, KY 40223. Only completed application forms, accompanied by the pedigree chart that ties you to Richard Wells, will be considered for the scholarship.

#### SCHOLARSHIP DECISION
