He married (3) NANCY BUTCHER, daughter of Jacob Butcher and Artie Dotson on 19 May 1853 in Johnson County, Kentucky. She was born on 18 May 1838 in Johnson, Virginia. Notes for George Eireland Wells:

From the George E Wells Family Genealogy, Wells Family Association: George E. Wells, the second child of Richard and Susanna Hutcheson Wells, was born March 22, 1800 in what was then Russell County, Virginia. He died on Johns Creek in Floyd County, Kentucky on December 14, 1887. George E. Wells was buried in the Allen Wells Cemetery on Johns Creek, but was later moved to the Auxier Relocation Cemetery. The move was necessary due to the Dewey Dam project on Johns Creek. George E. Wells was married twice, and possibly three times. He married

Elizabeth (Delong) Gaines, widow of Noble Gaines, on September 29, 1831. After Elizabeth's death in 1852, George married Nancy Butcher, daughter of Jacob and Artie Dotson Butcher. George may have been married to Sally Young before he married Elizabeth, but family tradition seems to disprove this. According to family tradition, when George married Elizabeth, Sally Young brought her young son to George's house and said, "Here George Wells is your son." George accepted the boy, George Washington Wells, and raised him from that day. George Washington Wells' death certificate lists him as being the son of George E. Wells and Sally Young.

Although George E. Wells lived most of his married life on Daniel's Creek, he was living in Floyd County on Johns Creek at his death. He moved to Johns Creek before 1880. His wife Nancy Butcher Wells lived on Johns Creek after his death. She died there in 1900.

Elizabeth (Delong) Gaines had one daughter, Rebecca, by Noble Gaines, and Rebecca went by Wells in later years. James W. Wells was born before George E. and Elizabeth were married, but there seems little doubt that James was George's son.

vii. JOHN PRESTON WELLS was born on 14 Mar 1815 in Virginia. He died in 1880 in Lawrence County, Ohio. He married Nancy Ann Webb on 04 Dec 1839 in Floyd County, Kentucky. She was born about 1823 in Kentucky. She died on 21 Aug 1895 in Huntington, Cabell County, West Virginia.

Notes for John Preston Wells:

John Preston Wells was born March 14, 1815 in Virginia, the son of Richard Wells and Susannah Hutchinson. The family moved to Floyd County, Kentucky between 1820 and 1830, where they lived for many years. In the

late 1830s, John received land grants on Oak Log Fork of Daniels Creek, in Johnson County, and in the 1850s, he received additional land grants on Daniels Creek. On December 4, 1839 in Floyd County, John married Nancy Ann Webb. John and Nancy had the following children: Alexander, William, Peter, Julia, Martha, Margaret, Malissa, and Edward. During the Civil War, John enlisted in the Conferate Army in 1861, in Company H of the fifth Kentucky Infantry at Prestonsburg. He was discharged in 1862 and reenlisted as a private in Company K of the thirteenth Kentucky Cavalry. He took part in a raid on a Union-owned store and in 1865, he was indicted by the Johnson County Circuit Court. At that time, John had already sold his land in Kentucky and moved to Lawrence County, Ohio, where he purchased more land. He surrendered and took the oath of allegiance to the US. He died in 1880 and was buried in the Perkins Ridge Cemetery in Windsor Township, Lawrence County, Ohio.

She and William lived in Floyd County in the Johns' Creek area. They had 3 children, Juliann, Cynthia, and William before her untimely death in 1842 or 1843. She was probably buried in an unmarked grave in the Webb-Butcher cemetery in Van Lear, Johnson County, Kentucky, the cemetery where her husband, William Webb, was also buried.

Richard and Susannah (Hutchison) Wells had eleven children, all born in Virginia. William Green Wells, the youngest son, was born at Dungannon, in Scott County, Viginia, in 1818. He was given the middle name of iGreenî in honor of Susannah Hutchisonís mother, Nancy (Green) Hutchisonís, who was the daughter of Lewis Green, Sr. William lived with his parents in their little cabin on Danielís Creek until his fatherís death. At that point he took over his fatheris small farm and a trading business the two had established just before Richardís death. On January 15, 1939, William married Mary Butcher, the daughter of Jacob Butcher, also of Scott County, Virginia. Since Jacob Butcher did not move to Kentucky until the mid 1840is it is likely that Wells traveled back to Virginia in search of a bride.

William Green Wells quickly developed a reputation as a hard worker and shrewd businessman. On November 2, 1842, he mortgaged all his possessions including iOne Bay Horse about seven years old. Martin & Co. for \$144.59 in order to purchase merchandise for his store. As the only store on Danielsís Creek, the risk paid off. By 1846, his holdings had increased to 800 acres of farmland and one lot in the town of Paintsville, on estate valued for taxes at \$905.00. Beginning in 1855, he took advantage of the Kentucky state grants program to acquire thousands of acres of ivacantî land in what are now Johnson, Flovd, and Martin counties. By 1857, he controlled 6,050 acres on the waters of Danielís Creek, Greasy Creek, and Rockcastle Creek. For unknown reasons, in 1857 he traded his lands on Daniels Creek for additional acreage on the right fork of Greasy Creek and moved his family across is now the community of Boonscamp. Wells built a new two-story log house at the junction of imiddle forkî and imain Greasyî and located his store nearby. The farm of of William Green Wells quickly became the focal point of the greasy Creek area. In addition to being a merchant farmer, Wells became a minister in the Methodist

Episcopal Church South, a lieutenant in the local militia, and a country doctor. He performed over one hundred marriages between 1852 and 1875. Kozeeís ìEarly Families of Eastern & Southern Kentuckyî noted that ìreligion and service in the name of Christ was the passion of his life. The home of Dr. Wells land the generous hospitality of his wife were the boon and comfort of the traveling Methodist ministry of those early days.î The Big Sandy Valley. published by William Ely in 1887, described him as a prominent man in the ministry, and Ö.also (as) a physician. He is well known in the Upper Valley, and his talent is highly appreciated, both at home and abroad.î About 1855, Wells and two of his sons began a successful mule trading business. At least twice per year, large numbers of young mules were driven to Newnan in Coweta County, Georgia, where they were sold to cotton planters. In 1858, the Newnan newspaper announced the formation of a partnership iDent & Wells Co. -Mule Traders, offering the finest old Kentucky stock.î Politically, Dr. Wells was a staunch Democrat and was a vocal supporter of the Southern Democrat John C. Breckinridge in the Presidential election of 1860. Undoubtedly, he had much do with Breckinridge's overwhelming victory in Johnson County and that his Republican opponent Abraham Lincoln did not receive a single vote. During the War Between the States, he cast his lot with the Confederate States of America. Traveling to Cedar Bluff, Virginia, he enlisted on November 21, 1861, as a private in Company E of the 54th Virginia Infantry. Wells later affiliated with Co. E of the 5th Kentucky Infantry and fought in the Battle of Middle Creek, but was captured in Morgan County, Kentucky, on November 7, 1862. He was taken by his captors to Camp Chase at Columbus, Ohio, where he was held as a prisoner of war until exchanged on November 3, 1963. Upon his return to Johnson County, he formed his own ipartisan rangeri company called the Greasy Creek Guards. During the summer of 1864, this company was transferred to Col. William S. Smithís Battalion of Virginia Cavalry and Wells was commissioned as a captain. Although attached to Smithis command, the company continued to act as an independent command carrying out raids against Unionists in Johnson, Floyd and Lawrence counties. One raid during the fall of 1864 resulted in a postwar lawsuit. John Howes of Paintsville claimed that Captain Wells iwhilst in the company of a military body Ö in arms against the Government of the United States did take four head of horses and other property.î By October 1864, Wells and his men were a part of Colonel Edwin Trimbleís 10th Kentucky Cavalry, C.S.A., Captain Wells commanded a company of the 10th until January 1865 when his men were transferred to the 13th. Georgia Cavalry. Taking command of K of the 13th Georgia, Wells and some of his men were detached for duty in Georgia in February 1865. For two weeks in February, Capt. Wells was a patient in a Confederate hospital at Newnan, Georgia, suffering from idiarrhea.iHe returned to duty late in February and led his command back to Virginia. Capt. Wells was a patient in a Confederate hospital at Newnan, Georgia, suffering from "diarrhea." He returned to duty late in February and led his command back to Virginia. He remained with the Georgia regiment until the unity disbanded near Christiansburg, Virginia on April 12, 1865. Upon his return to Kentucky his men were forced from their homes by occupying Union soldiers. They returned to the field until forced to surrender at Charleston, West Virginia, on June 12, 1865, over two months after Lee's surrender at Appomattox. The war exacted a terrific toll on Wells and his family. His store was closed by occupying Union troops and much of his property was either sold in order to supply his men or was confiscated by the enemy. In 1866, his property included less than 1700 acres of land, one hog, and 10 cattle. In spite of these setbacks. Wells reopened the store and continued the practice of medicine and the "propagation of the gospel." He also re-established his mule business in Georgia, although postwar conditions in that state made trading far less lucrative than in the years before the War. However, his

passion for the issues surrounding the war did not diminish. A Union sympathizer from nearby Cassville, West Virginia, reported that "on March 19h [1866] Capt. Willie Wells of Johnson co." confronted him "hurrahing for Jeff Davis, defying everybody" and "abused me as a d d Abolitionist." His views did not alter his respected position in the community. In 1872, he was appointed as one of three commissioners to select a county seat for the new county of Martin. It was his suggestion that placed the seat at its current location of Inez, Kentucky. In 1870, he reorganized his mule trading company along with a group of wartime friends from Coweta County, Georgia. During Reconstruction, the Deep South suffered from a severe shortage of farm animals, a need Capt. Wells was all too happy to fulfill. For almost ten years, Wells drove hundreds of Kentucky mules to market at Newnan, Moreland and Senoia, Georgia. Capt. Wells became so prominent that the main street in the Coweta County town of Senoia was renamed iWells Street.î As his age advanced and health problems increased, William Green Wells moved to the town of Paintsville, Kentucky. On April 17, 1883, he purchased "a house and lot on the southeast corner of Cross and Back streets leading from the Methodist Church to the tanyard." This spot is now the location of the World War I memorial at the corner of Court and Second streets. While in Paintsville he assisted in the organization of the Johnson County Battalion of the East Kentucky Confederate Veterans Society and served as an officer until his death. Possibly sensing his end, Wells sold his Paintsville home to his son John P. Wells on April 30, 1886, and moved back to the farm on Greasy Creek where he died less than a year later. Initially, he was buried in the old Ward Cemetery at Offutt, Kentucky, but later the grave was moved to the J.B. Wells Cemetery on Depot Road in Paintsville. Just after his death, a new Methodist Church organized on Greasy Creek and was named "Wells Chapel Methodist Church" in his honor. The first minister was his son, Rev. Aaron Wells. William Green and Mary (Butcher) Wells had thirteen children. Of their eight sons, four served in the Confederate Army and one for the Union, four were farmers, two were lawyers, one owned a general merchandise store, one became a teacher, two served as elected county officials, one served in the Kentucky General Assembly, and four became postmasters.

On December 4, 1839 in Floyd County, John married Nancy Ann Webb. John and Nancy had the following children: Alexander, William, Peter, Julia, Martha, Margaret, Malissa, and Edward. During the Civil War, John enlisted in the Confederate Army in 1861, in Company H of the fifth Kentucky Infantry at Prestonsburg. He was discharged in 1862 and reenlisted as a private in Company K of the thirteenth Kentucky Cavalry. He took part in a raid on a Union-owned store and in 1865, he was indicted by the Johnson County Circuit Court. At that time, John had already sold his land in Kentucky and moved to Lawrence County, Ohio, where he purchased more land. He surrendered and took the oath of allegiance to the US. He died in 1880 and was buried in the Perkins Ridge Cemetery in Windsor Township, Lawrence County, Ohio.
